SUMMER CAMP



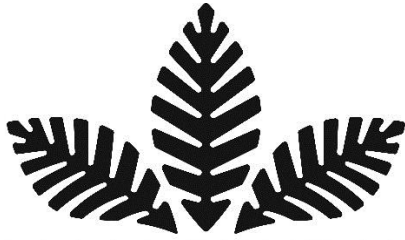
